TESTS FOR EXAMINATION OF THE KNEE. MCMURRAY'S TEST is a knee examination test that elicits pain or painful click as the knee is brought from flexion to extension with either internal or external rotation. This test uses the tibia to trap the meniscus between the femoral condyle and tibia.

Note: With all three orthopedic assessment tests for thoracic outlet syndrome, Adson's, Eden's, Wright's, the criterion is a decrease in the STRENGTH of the radial pulse. The speed/rate of the pulse has nothing to do with the mechanics of these tests.
